Information regarding the Sports Premium Grant

The Sports Premium Grant is additional funding from the Government to improve the provision of physical education and sport in primary schools. It is also to be used for improving the health and wellbeing of primary pupils. The funding is provided jointly by the Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport.

Allocation for the 2016/17 academic year

In 2016/17 Ebor Gardens Academy received £9,710, which was spent as follows:

To ensure that these improvements are sustainable in the future the following actions will be taken:

- Strengthen links and partnerships with other academies within Wellspring Academy Trust
- Continuing to provide relevant CPD opportunities
- Providing a range of clubs run by qualified teachers or coaches
- Increase staff participation with activities in the playground

It is expected that the academy will receive £9,710 for the 2017/18 academic year. A full and detailed plan will be published at the start of the new academic year.
