We work closely with West Yorkshire Police to support children who live in households where there are incidents of domestic violence and abuse. Confidential information is provided to schools on any incidents of domestic violence and abuse which occur within a child's household that might have an impact on a child whilst they are in school. Members of the school staff (Miss Dooley and Mrs Roebuck), are trained to use the information that has been shared, in confidence, so that the school is able to make provision for possible difficulties experienced by children or their families.
